

**Bylaws and conditions of international sports competition  
„Spaceman Championship 2017“  
(hereinafter referred to as „Bylaws“)**

**Section I  
Introductory provisions**

1. Competition titled „Spaceman Championship“ (hereinafter referred to as „Competition“) is organized by Spaceman Organization s.r.o. (Pvt. Ltd. Company), with registered office at Šustekova 8, 851 04 Bratislava, Company Registration No.: 50 247 158, registered in Companies register of the District Court Bratislava I, Section: Sro, Insert No.: 110372/B (hereinafter referred to as „Organizer“).
2. Competition stated in Art. 1, Section I of the Bylaws **IS NOT** a consumer contest as defined under the Consumer Protection Act No. 250/2007 Coll. and on amendment to the act of the Slovak National Council No. 372/1990 Coll. on offences as amended and the main prize of the Competition **IS NOT** the prize under the act No. 171/2005 Coll. on games of chance and amending and supplementing certain acts.
3. Rules and conditions as defined in these Bylaws shall apply to the Competition, Event and all the Participants, and persons concerned and Participants are obliged to comply with and respect them.

**Section II  
Basic Information and Interpretation of Terms**

1. The Competition shall begin on 23.02.2017, upon the tickets sale and Competition registration start. The Competition shall end upon announcing the overall winner of the Competition.
2. The Competition event shall take place on 01.09.2017 at Divoká voda Čunovo complex, Bratislava 59, Čunovo – dams, Slovak Republic (hereinafter referred to as „Event“).
3. For the purposes of these Bylaws are the following terms defined as follows:
  - a) **Spaceman Championship Competition** as an international sports competition in extreme conditions, from the point of paying an entry fee and registration, through the sports Event, until declaring the winner of the main prize of the Competition.
  - b) **Event** as competing itself between the Participants in stages and in various sports disciplines on 01.09.2017 at Divoká voda Čunovo complex, Bratislava 59, Čunovo – dams, Slovak Republic.
  - c) **Registration** as activation of bar code from the ticket bought as an entry fee to the Competition at Event venue.
  - d) **Participant** as a person interested in taking part in the Competition that bought a ticket and registered at Event venue, and subsequently participating in the Event with the aim of winning the main prize of the Competition.
  - e) **Entry fee** as a fee for entering the Competition that also includes the start package.
  - f) **Organizer of the Competition** as legal entity as stated in Art. 1, Sec I of the Bylaws that organizes the Competition, as well as persons acting in its name and its official representatives (security, health and emergency service, volunteers).
  - g) **Stage of the Competition** as level – point score that Participant must achieve in order to advance to the following stage of the Competition.
  - h) **Finals** as 4th stage of the Competition.
  - i) **Finalist of the Competition** as Participant taking part in the finals competing for the main prize of the Competition.
  - j) **Winner of the Competition** as Participant winning the main prize of the Competition.
  - k) **Force majeure** as such weather conditions – weather that prevent Participant from taking part in the Event as well as the decision of the Divoká voda Čunovo complex, Bratislava 59, Čunovo – dams, Slovak Republic not to make the complex available to the Organizer on agreed days and times of the Event.

**Section III**  
**Conditions for Participation in the Competition and Rules of the Competition**

1. Any natural person complying with the conditions of the Competition and attains the age of eighteen upon the beginning of the Competition can enter the Competition. Persons younger than eighteen years and persons that are in employment relationship or relationship similar to employment relationship with the Organizer of the Competition cannot participate in the Competition.
2. Natural person shall enter the Competition upon purchase of the ticket at website [www.spcmn.sk/store](http://www.spcmn.sk/store) (hereinafter referred to as „Entry fee“). In case of applying discount to the price of the ticket, discounts cannot be combined.
3. Ticket price is 49,- EUR
4. Entry fee includes, apart from the participation in the Competition itself, the start package containing 1 pc of Spaceman Championship T-shirt, Spaceman stickers, 1 pc of time keeper chip, refreshments, online profile of the player, list of top results, shower, changing room, storage room, parking place for one vehicle within the complex of the Competition. For Participant advancing to the 3rd stage of the Competition the Entry fee also includes accommodation in the training camp and food (half board, snacks for one day).
5. Natural person shall become the Participant of the Competition upon registering a bar code from the purchased ticket (Entry fee) at the Event venue
6. Upon entering the Event, Participant of the Competition is obliged to submit to the Organizer filled health status declaration signed in manuscript as well as consent to the processing of personal data of the person concerned in accordance with Personal Data Protection Act No. 122/2013 Coll. as amended, thus expressing his agreement to the conditions of the Competition.
7. Organizer is authorized not to permit Participant to compete at the Event, even in case of Participant paying the Entry fee, if Participant stated incomplete, inaccurate or untrue information upon registration or if Participant does not submit health status declaration signed in manuscript and consent for the processing of personal data of the person concerned to the Organizer.
8. Entry fee cannot be transferred to another person. In case Participant shall not be present at the Event or does not start the 1st stage of the Competition, he is not entitled to the Entry fee reimbursement.
9. The Competition consists of four (4) stages whereas each stage includes the following disciplines:
  1. stage: online tests (Qualification), obstacle race (maximum of 10 obstacles with time measurement)
  2. stage: X-plane simulator, mental and pilot testing, hydrospeed in wildwater, secret zipline discipline, spaceman workout race
  3. stage: orbiter space simulator, cardio bicycle and rowing, health check, flying a drone, building and launching a model rocket
  4. stage - finals: jump off a plane, diving, centrifuge, certified flight simulator, mountain orienteering, secret final discipline.
10. The Competition finals (4th stage) shall commence upon reaching the number of 10 best Participants of the Competition, a situation that can occur within the second year of the Competition. In case any one of the 10 best Participants shall not be interested in waiting for the opening of the second year of the Competition he can exchange his entry to the finals for a zero gravity flight ZeroG in accordance with Sec. VI, Art. 4 of the Bylaws, thus, however, renouncing the possibility to take part in the finals.

**Section IV**  
**Evaluation of the Competition**

1. Every Participant competes on his own behalf in the Competition. When competing at the Event, Participants do not form any teams or squads.
2. Results for each stage shall be announced within one hour of finishing the particular stage on the spot of the race.

3. Best 10% of all the Participants from each stage shall move on to the next stage. In case the said 10% does not constitute an integer, this number shall be rounded down to an integer.
4. In case two Participants reach the same results within a particular stage of the Event, the advance to the next stage shall be decided by the fact which one of them succeeds better at an additional task determined by the Organizer at a particular place and time of the Event.
5. Participant of the Event can file a written objection regarding preliminary results, violation of rules, track or behavior or actions of other Participants on a prescribed form that shall be available with the Organizer of the Event, however, no later than 30 minutes prior to the completion of the particular stage. Announcement of the results from the particular stage shall be considered completion of the stage. Filing an objection shall be charged with the amount (advance) of 20 EUR that shall be returned to the Participant in case of an admissible objection. The Organizer is obliged to decide regarding the objection by the end of the particular stage of the Event.

#### **Section V**

##### **Disqualification and Cancellation of the Competition**

1. In the entire course of the Event the Organizer is entitled to disqualify Participant from the Event (hereinafter referred to as „Disqualification“) and the Competition in case of Participant cheating or violating rules and conditions of the Event and Competition as defined by these Bylaws in any way while competing, thus trying to achieve more favorable result for himself at the Competition.
2. Disqualification shall end the Participant’s participation in the Competition and he shall not be entitled to the reimbursement of nor a part of neither full Entry fee.
3. In case of force majeure or insufficient number of registered Participants, the Organizer can cancel the Competition. In case of cancellation of the Competition, the Organizer can after considering all circumstances and quantifying reasonably incurred costs refund a part of or full Entry fee to the Participants.

#### **Section VI**

##### **Winner of the Competition and the Competition prizes**

1. The Participant who completes 4th stage of the Event with the best results shall become the overall winner of the Competition.
2. The main prize of the Competition is a sub-orbital flight (flight to space) worth 150 000,- USD.
3. The main prize of the Competition is guaranteed only in case the number of Participants starting at the Event reaches 9 999 Participants.
4. In case the number of Participants starting at the Event shall not reach the number stated in Art. 3 of Section herein, the winner wins a ZeroG parabolic flight worth 9000,- EUR (second guaranteed prize).
5. Third guaranteed prize of the Competition is a certificate for fighter plane flight worth 700,- EUR.
6. Fourth guaranteed prize of the Competition is a Luminox watch worth 400,- EUR.

#### **Section VII**

##### **Exclusion of liability**

1. The Participant shall assume all the risks resulting from the participation in the Competition, shall bear full responsibility for potential injury or accident to his or other person participating in the Event and by agreement to these Bylaws undertakes not to claim compensation for damages to property or injury from the Organizer.

2. Participant takes note and agrees that the Organizer shall not bear responsibility for potential injury or damages to property and belonging of the Participants of the Event. For potential injury or damages to property and belongings shall bear responsibility the Participant of the Event that caused such injury or damages.
3. Participant is aware that he is obliged to ensure his own safety and not to endanger other Participants of the Event by his actions.
4. Participant takes note that in case of any violation of the conditions of the Event, safety and organizational instructions he shall be disqualified from the Competition without any reimbursement of Entry fee and other expenses.
5. It is the responsibility of the Participant to ensure particular physical examination for himself and acquire information on his health condition in relation to the Competition.

**Section VIII**  
**Final provisions**

1. The Organizer of the Competition reserves the right to make decisions on all matters relating to the Competition at his discretion and also reserves the right to limit, adjourn, amend or cancel or retract these Bylaws, the Competition and its rules.
2. By paying the Entry fee the Participant expresses his agreement with all the conditions of the Competition.
3. The Organizer shall not bear responsibility for any damages incurred as a result of inaccurate data provided by the Participant of the Competition, or failure to employ, pick up, assume or make use of the prize of the Competition. Also, the Organizer of the Competition shall not pay any compensation to the Participants of the Competition incurred in relation to their participation in the Competition, or the main prize.
4. Winner cannot transfer his claim to the main prize to third person.
5. Participation in the Competition is voluntary and by entering the Competition the Participants of the Competition express their agreement to the rules and conditions of the Competition and undertake to abide by these Bylaws.
