

# ORGANIZATIONAL AND VISITOR REGULATIONS „SPACEMAN CHAMPIONSHIP“

## Section I

### Introductory provisions

- (1) Spaceman Organization s.r.o. (Pvt. Ltd. Company) with registered office at Šustekova 8, 851 04 Bratislava, Company registration No.: 50 247 158, registered at Companies register of the District Court Bratislava I, Section: Sro, Insert No. 110372/B, as organizer of the Event issues in accordance with § 6 of the Act No. 1/2014 Coll. on public sports events organization and amending and supplementing certain acts these Organizational and visitor regulations (hereinafter referred to as „Regulations“) of a sports event under the title **Spaceman Championship** (hereinafter referred to as „Event“) organized by Spaceman Organization s.r.o. (hereinafter referred to as „Organizer“). These Organizational and visitor regulations of the Event determine binding rules of conduct for the participants of the Event.
- (2) The aim of the Organizational and visitor regulations is to regulate safety, health, property and environment protection of the Event participants and details related to the viewers participation at the Event.
- (3) The Event is a public sports event accessible to the public that shall take place on 01.09.2017 for the participants based on their registration with the Organizer, at Divoká Voda Čunovo complex, Bratislava 59, Čunovo – dams, Slovakia, according to the approved Event track map published at website [www.spacemanchampionship.com](http://www.spacemanchampionship.com) (hereinafter referred to as „Event website“).
- (4) Each participant at the Event is obliged to comply with obligations, guidelines and instructions:
  - a) stated in these Organizational regulations of the Event,
  - b) stated on the information sheet issued for the Event and within rules and conditions stated at the Event website that are available at the presentation of the Events participants,
  - c) of safety markings at the Event site,
  - d) of members of operational team, members of private security service that ensure organization of traffic on public communications and protection of public order at the Event,
  - e) of members of health and emergency service, and of fire and other brigades.
- (5) The Event participant is mainly an active registered participant – runner, viewer (visitor – public), and journalist, member of a realization sports team, other natural person ensuring course of the Event.
- (6) Registration with the Event Organizer shall be defined for the purposes of these Regulations as purchase of the ticket at website [www.predpredaj.sk](http://www.predpredaj.sk) or at [www.eventbrite.com](http://www.eventbrite.com) as Entry fee for the Event, and subsequent creation of a personal profile based on the bar code on the ticket at the Event website.
- (7) The Event Organizer shall bear responsibility for injuries and damages to property caused by the Event participant only in case they were caused by violation of legal regulations of the Slovak Republic on part of the Event Organizer, deliberate or negligent conduct on part of natural persons that are in employment relationship or other contractual relationship with the Event Organizer, and the Event participant reported the damage or injury to the Event Organizer.
- (8) The Event Operator is a natural person authorized by the Organizer.

## Section II

### Participant's entry and stay at the Event

- (1) Active participant of the Event shall have to provide evidence of his person upon entry to the Event site in the form of registration or other document authorizing him to enter the Event.
- (2) Upon request by a member of the operational team, member of private security service that ensure public order protection at the Event, the participant is obliged to provide evidence of his person in the form of registration or other document authorizing him to enter the Event. In case he fails to evidence his registration he is obliged to leave the Event site. If he fails to do so he can be escorted from the Event.

### **Section III Authorizations of the Operator**

- (1) The Event Operator is authorized to:
  - a) make sure whether a natural person wanting to take part in the Event is authorized to do so,
  - b) make sure by means of visual, tactile check or technical equipment that a natural person entering the Event site does not carry with him, including in hand baggage, or on his person a firearm, pyrotechnic product or other object able to render physical attack more aggressive, alcoholic beverages, if municipality issued a ban on selling, serving or consuming alcoholic beverages at the Event, drugs or psychotropic substances,
  - c) not to allow entry or prevent entry to the Event of a natural person carrying to the Event site a firearm, pyrotechnic product or other object able to make physical attack more aggressive, alcoholic beverages, if municipality issued a ban on selling, serving or consuming alcoholic beverages at the Event, drugs or psychotropic substances,
  - d) not to allow entry or prevent entry to the Event of a natural person that clearly is under the influence of alcohol, drugs or psychotropic substances,
  - e) warn the Event participants of their inappropriate conduct and request they refrain from it, if they violate public order or disturb peaceful course of the Event by their conduct,
  - f) instruct the Event participants to leave the Event without a compensation of entrance fee, if they continue their inappropriate conduct after warning, violate public order or disturb peaceful course of the Event,
  - g) escort the Event participants and ban their further participation in the Event without compensation of entrance fee, if they defied the instruction to leave the Event,
  - h) request the Event participant to identify himself in relation to his violation of the Event participant obligations, evidence and hand his identification data over to other authorized persons and authorities.

### **Section IV Obligations and restrictions for the Event participant**

- (1) The Event participant is obliged to:
  - a) follow instructions of the Event Organizer, operational team and members of private security service ensuring public order at the Event and refrain from anything that would violate public order or peaceful course of the Event,
  - b) refrain from consuming alcoholic beverages in the course of the Event, if municipality issued a ban on selling, serving or consuming alcoholic beverages at the Event, refrain from consuming drugs or psychotropic substances in the course of the Event,
  - c) endure actions on part of the Organizer, operator, members of police forces, local (municipal) police forces or member of private security service related to the violation of the Event participant obligations,
  - d) disperse peacefully, leave the Event site following the end of the Event.
- (2) It is prohibited for the Event participant to carry to the Event:
  - a) firearms and other weapons and objects able to render physical attack more aggressive (for ex. daggers, stickers, knives, rods, batons, glass bottles, chairs, mounts) with the exception of a case when he has the Event Organizer's consent to carry the said weapons and objects in,
  - b) explosives and pyrotechnic products,
  - c) aerosol cans, corrosive, flammable and coloring substances or other substances posing a health risk,
  - d) alcoholic beverages, if municipality issued a ban on selling, serving or consuming alcoholic beverages at the Event,
  - e) drugs or psychotropic substances,
  - f) racist, vulgar, derogative or good manners contradicting banners, sheets and other promotional materials,
  - g) power operated equipment or equipment causing noise,
  - h) animals,
  - i) laser pointers or other objects whose light and other radiation impacts negatively the Event participants including competing athletes and judges,
  - j) is prohibited to attend the Event under the influence of alcohol or psychotropic substances,
- (3) Prohibitions as stated in Art. 2 letter a), b), c), g), h), i) a j) shall not apply to natural persons that have the Organizer's consent to carry the said weapons and objects to the Event.
- (4) It is prohibited for the Event participant to:

- a) have his face covered in such a way that prevents his identification, if an official intervention is being carried out against him by members of police forces and a member of police forces asked him to uncover his face,
- b) use national emblems of foreign states or their predecessors in a derogative way or other way that might induce violation of public order or disturbance of peaceful course of the Event,
- c) speak and chant racist, vulgar, derogative and good manners contradicting words and slogans,
- d) enter spaces of the Event site not intended for the viewers (visitors) of the Event,
- e) throw within the Event site objects posing a risk to health and safety of the Event participants,
- f) build fires and use pyrotechnic products at the Event site,
- g) excite public nuisance,
- h) pollute the Event site, also by means of poster display, commercial and advertising call sheets,
- i) destroy and damage the Event site and its equipment,
- j) bother and physically attack and beat the Event participants,
- k) sell goods and services without permission from the Event Organizer.

#### **Section V Escorting the Event participant out**

- (1) Organizer, member of the operational team, member of private security service that ensure public order protection at the Event may call Police or escort out themselves such Event participant without compensation of Entry fee who shall:
  - a) not comply with the instructions of the Event Organizer, operational service and members of private security service ensuring public order protection at the Event,
  - b) disturb public order or orderly and peaceful course of the Event,
  - c) consume alcoholic beverages, if the municipality issued a ban on selling, serving or consuming alcoholic beverages at the Event,
  - d) consume drugs and other psychotropic substances in the course of the Event,
  - e) refuse to uncover his face upon request by a member of police forces,
  - f) use national emblems of foreign states or their predecessors in a derogative way or other way that might induce violation of public order or threaten peaceful course of the Event,
  - g) speak and chant racist, vulgar, derogative and good manners contradicting words and slogans, or present them on banners, posters and so on,
  - h) enter spaces of the Event site not intended for the viewers (visitors) of the Event, for example spaces intended for competing athletes, members of realization teams of athletes, judges, organizers,
  - i) throw within the Event site objects posing risk to health and safety of the Event participants,
  - j) build fires and use pyrotechnic products at the Event site,
  - k) excite public nuisance,
  - l) pollute the Event site (also by means of poster display, commercial and advertising call sheets),
  - m) destroy and damage the Event site and its equipment,
  - n) bother and physically attack and beat the Event participants,
  - o) sell goods and services without permission from the Event Organizer.

#### **Section VI Validity**

- (1) Other rights and obligations of the Event participants not specifically laid down by these Organizational and visitor regulations are covered by the relevant provisions of Act No. 1/2014 Coll. on public sports events organization as amended.
- (2) These Organizational and visitor regulations were approved by the Event Organizer on 22.02.2017 and are effective as of 01.09.2017.
